NEW DELHI, APRIL 7 (ENA) The first convocation ceremony of Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Nagpur, will take place on April 14 according to sources. The first batch of Post Graduate Programme (PGP) 2015-17 will be receiving diplomas during the convocation ceremony. The ceremony will be conducted at the auditorium of Visveswaraya National Institute of Technology.

Union Minister of Road Transport and Highways, Nitin Gadkari, will be the chief guest. The management of IIM Nagpur is making all out efforts to invite Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi. An official of IIM Nagpur revealed that PM Modi is likely to visit Nagpur city on the same day and the management is trying its best to invite him.

Director of IIM Nagpur, L.S. Murty, revealed that the convocation ceremony would be conducted in a grand manner. The management has been working consistently
